Tournament Dates:

The **RSEQ GMAA Competitive Golf tournament** will be held Wednesday, September 17th, 2025.
The **RSEQ GMAA Best Ball Golf Tournament** will be held Thursday, September 25th, 2025.

Tournament Format:

Depending on the number of students registered, students will either be assigned a tee time, or we will host a shotgun start.

- If tee times are assigned, students must check-in with the organizers 20 minutes prior to their tee time.
- If there is a shotgun start, students must arrive by 7:15am for registration. The shotgun will start at 8:00am sharp.

Any student missing the start (either their tee time or the shotgun) will count the maximum for the hole(s) missed.

Location: Caughnawaga Golf Club - Road 207 South c.p. 840, Kahnawake, Québec, J0L 1B0

Entry Deadline through S1: All team and player entries are due Tuesday, September 9th by 11:59pm. Players' handicaps must be indicated on their player registration on S1 in the 'Additional Information' Section.

Classification: Boys or Girls

Bantam, Cadet, or Juvenile

Division 3 – Competitive Tournament

Division 4 – Best Ball Tournament

Regardless of students' handicap, coaches have the option to register their students in the competitive tournament (D3) or the best ball tournament (D4). Students can only compete in one of the tournaments, competitive or best ball.

Total Number of Golfers per school: Depending on total number of golfers, if there is limited space in either tournament, RSEQ GMAA schools may be capped at one foursome per category, the first four golfers from each school will be guaranteed. GMAA member entries will be accepted before any non-members are considered. Additional golfers will be added in even increments, based on space.

Team Competition: Depending on total number of golfers, if there is limited space in the D3 Competitive Tournament, RSEQ GMAA schools may be capped at one foursome per category. In that case, schools entering more than one D3 foursome must declare the four students who will be eligible to compete for the team banner. If there is no cap to the number of students registered in the D3 Competitive Tournament, the lowest 4 scores will count for the team competition. All students registered in the D3 tournament will be eligible for individual awards.

Best Ball Teams: Schools with 4 or more athletes in the D4 tournament may compete together as a team. If a school has fewer than 4 best ball golfers, they will be combined with other schools into foursomes. Students in D4 are eligible for a team banner or individual awards. The winning best ball foursome will receive mini bannerettes.



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Cost: 80\$ per golfer (Non-member schools would have an added fee of \$80 per school.) This is an estimated cost; all schools will be invoiced for the total amount following the tournament.

Substitutions on Tournament Day: Substitutions can be made when you check in at the tournament. If D3 numbers are capped, the make-up of your team (four golfers chosen for the team competition) must be identified during check-in. No additions will be accepted.

Staff Officials: Each coach will accompany a foursome and act as the official scorer for that group. This person will tally and hand in the official score card at the end of the tournament. Please note that if your school is entering more than 1 foursome you will be required to supply extra people to act as the scorers. The additional person does not need to be a staff member but must be a qualified adult.

A limited number of pull carts are available for students to rent; this must be paid for in the pro shop. Carts will be available for staff members, you will be asked to sign for them, and the cost will be charged to the school.

The tournament will follow:

- Winter rules with a 6" preferred lie will be used.
- Lost ball, out of bounds, water etc. will all be treated as a lateral hazard and the penalty will be 1 stroke, and the ball may be dropped 2 club lengths latterly from where it went out.
- Maximum number of strokes: A maximum of 5 over par will be permitted on any hole. At that point, the ball is to be picked up and that number is to be recorded on the score card. (8 on a par 3, 9 on par 4 and 10 on a par 5).

Caddies and coaching will not be permitted on the course. Parents must stay at least 50yds from the golfers and may not communicate with them. Please advise your students of this policy.

Handbook and Governing Rules – See copy of the handbook on the RSEQ GMAA Website. Please make sure that your students respect the dress code and come in appropriate golf attire.

Range Finders are permitted.

The snack bar will be open during the tournaments.
