## GMAA PICKLEBALL TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

### Tournament Date(s), Times & Locations

Bantam Girls – November 11<sup>th</sup> 3:45pm – 6:00pm at John Rennie HS  
Bantam Boys – November 6<sup>th</sup> 8:00am – 4:00pm at Bialik HS (with Cadet Boys)  
Cadet Girls – October 23<sup>rd</sup> 12:00pm – 2:30pm at Bilaik HS  
Cadet Boys – November 6<sup>th</sup> 8:00am – 4:00pm at Bialik HS (with Bantam Boys)  
Juvenile Girls – October 28<sup>th</sup> 8:30am – 3:00pm at St George's School  
Juvenile Boys – November 8<sup>th</sup> 9:30am – 2:30pm at West Island College

**Team Entry Deadline:** Team entries are due September 24<sup>th</sup> by 11:59pm on S1.

**Player Registration Deadline:** 48 hours prior to the scheduled tournament on S1.

**Classification:** Boys or Girls

Bantam or Juvenile

Bantam Girls, Bantam Boys, Juvenile Girls, Juvenile Boys

**Teams:** A team is made up of 6 players (like badminton) 2 singles players and 2 doubles teams.  
Schools may enter a maximum of 2 teams per category.

**Cost:** approximately \$350 per team (This is an estimated cost; all schools will be invoiced following the tournament.) The cost will include rental of the facility, awards, administrative fees, etc.

**Staff Member:** Each School must provide a staff member for the duration of the tournament.

**Scoring:** For Round Robin Games: Game will be played with rally scoring up to 15 points. A game must be won by 2 points up to a maximum of 21 points. (Example, game is tied 20-20 next point wins).  
For Playoff Games: Traditional Pickleball scoring will be used. Only the serving team will score points. Games will be up to 11 points. A game must be won by 2 points up to a maximum of 15 points. (Example, game is tied 14-14 next point wins).

**Equipment:** All players must provide their own paddles for games, paddles cannot be shared, since the schedules for each team may overlap.

**Rules:** The official Pickleball Canada rules will be used with GMAA modifications that will be confirmed prior to the tournament.
